



The infection curves Measuring Covid spread in some EU countries

TAX MEASURES

- \Rightarrow Exemption of property tax
- \Rightarrow Reduction on WHT (WithHoldingTax)
- \Rightarrow Extension of deadlines for tax payments
- ⇒ Deduction of expenditures on necessary preventive measures
- \Rightarrow Several tax benefits (discounts)





TAX MEASURES

- \Rightarrow Tax suspension or deferral for falls in turnover:
 - \Rightarrow WithHolding Taxes
 - \Rightarrow VAT
 - \Rightarrow Social security contributions
- \Rightarrow Tax payment deferral for taxpayers in the 'red zone'
- \Rightarrow Tax credits for the purchase of workplace PPE
- \Rightarrow Tax credits transferrable
- \Rightarrow Extension of deadline for income taxes
- \Rightarrow Tax receipt lottery and Cashback



TAX MEASURES

- \Rightarrow Extension of deadline for Income taxes and VAT
- \Rightarrow LOSS CARRY-BACK
- \Rightarrow Tax reliefs for donations
- \Rightarrow Reduced VAT rate

TAX MEASURES

- \Rightarrow Deferral of VAT payments
- \Rightarrow Indirect Tax rates and reliefs
- \Rightarrow Waiver of import taxes on vital medical supplies
- \Rightarrow Income Tax payment deferral
- \Rightarrow Time To Pay requests to HMRC



- \Rightarrow Change in the rates of mandatory social insurance contributions:
 - \Rightarrow for persons deriving income
 - \Rightarrow Agriculture sector
 - \Rightarrow Lawyers, freelance accountants
- \Rightarrow Unemployed provided with a temporary allowance
- \Rightarrow Layoffs and jobcuts to be avoided





- \Rightarrow Extension of the social safety nets
- \Rightarrow Smartworking
- \Rightarrow Automatic extension of fixed-term employees
- \Rightarrow No termination of long-term or other kind of employees



- \Rightarrow Home work allowance
- \Rightarrow Employers can grant a consumption voucher
- \Rightarrow Cross-border workers taxation


- \Rightarrow Job Retention Scheme (JRS)

Cumulative number for 14 days of COVID-19 cases (per 100.000) 01 March 2020 - 18 September 2020 - (200 days)



The curve of infections in some EU countries


Cumulative number for 14 days of COVID-19 cases (per 100.000) - LOCKDOWN: Day 1 - Day 200
















Distribution of Covid-19 injured workers by gender (Jan 2020 – Feb 2021) WORK ACCIDENTS






Distribution of Covid-19 injured workers by gender (Jan 2020 – Feb 2021) FATAL CASES






Distribution of Covid-19 injured workers by economic activities January 2020 – February 2021 (NACE Classification) WORK ACCIDENTS
